# Palm Sunday Father Paul writes.....

This weekend we celebrate 'Palm Sunday'. The Gospel from St. Mark describes how Jesus approaches the gate of Jerusalem as he descends the Mount of Olives. Since that dramatic entrance, when Jesus entered Jerusalem for his trial, crucifixion and resurrection, Christians have recalled the event each year. Standing with palms and processing with them, we relive in liturgy of Holy Week, not only that event, but all the events that led to Jesus's death and resurrection.

These events of the Last Supper, the crucifixion and the resurrection, have their clearest and most intense presence and focus in the celebration of the Easter Triduum. The Triduum is a single liturgy spanning three days. That is why the fasting and abstinence from meat on Good Friday is, in a sense, part of that liturgy; it is a way of keeping our minds and prayer on the mystery of the Lord's Cross.

Baptism joins us to the death and resurrection of Jesus, which is why we renew our baptismal commitment at Easter. As part of that renewal, in which we all take part, Felicity Allegri and David Price will be received into the 'Full Communion of the Catholic Church'. Let us welcome them with joy and an assurance of prayer.

Please do all you can to attend the Easter Triduum and to support our two candidates for reception into the Church.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available at the normal times and in Ringwood on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March between 11.00am and 12 noon. There will also be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Canon Peter Wilkie is also available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation at Allenbrook Care Home at 34, Station Road, Fordingbridge. He is available during daylight hours.

On Maudy Thursday there will be a 'watching' and adoration at the Altar of Repose until 9.15pm starting after Mass. The time will end with Night Prayer.
