## The 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter Father Paul writes....

Our Gospel this weekend reminds us of Jesus's words that he is the vine, and we are the branches. As the Gospel narrative unfolds Jesus makes clear that this vine depends on us to bear fruit. In fact, Jesus speaks of "much fruit".

The mention of fruit and our part in bringing about a harvest leads us directly into our mission and work. Each of us has an indispensable part to play in the work of Jesus and of the Church which is to proclaim the message that God loves every person. For each person with whom we engage, we are enabled by virtue of our Baptism, to reveal the presence and action of the risen Jesus. We do this through the depth and quality of our love, our attentiveness, our readiness to listen, our generosity, our forgiveness and our welcome and respect. It is also for us to be conscious of the fact that it is for us to fan the flame of faith in each person who shares our lives.

Faith and hope in God, which comes from an awareness that Jesus is the vine and we are the branches, is a gift which we share with others. In fact, each of us will draw strength and encouragement in the living out of our faith from the example of the prayer and trusting commitment of the people of faith around us. While faith in God is immensely personal, that same faith is supported by seeing the faith of others. After all we are all branches of the same vine.

Coming together at Mass, Sunday by Sunday, is a precious moment when we can share faith and the events of our daily lives with others. Coming together to praise God and to give thanks will always involve communication and conversation. That is why the gathering before Mass and perhaps during coffee after Mass is so important. The communication may be a simple greeting or perhaps the more extended sharing of a faith experience, a prayer, or a significant life event. All of this is about being part of a Christian faith community.

Much of the communication and sharing may well happen before Mass in the church, or perhaps, afterwards. At the same time, it is important to remember the tradition and practice which is to have some moments of silent prayer before Mass begins. Our conversations with others in church should really conclude five minutes before Mass begins in order to provide some time for silence and recollection. Such a time of silence proclaims the importance and solemn significance of the celebration of Mass for each of us.

It is in those moments of silence before and during Mass that God speaks to our hearts.
