The Fifth Sunday of Lent Father Paul writes....

Our Gospel this Sunday, describes the fate of the woman caught in the act of committing adultery. The scribes and Pharisees were using the woman to trap Jesus so that he himself could be condemned. If he agreed that she should be stoned, then he was breaking the Roman Law which said that only the Roman Governor could make that decision. If he did not condemn her, then he was breaking the Mosaic Law.

Jesus did neither. Instead, he turned the tables on her accusers by inviting the one of them who was without sin to cast the first stone. In her shame and embarrassment, Jesus did not condemn the woman. He acknowledged her failing but did not question her about the circumstances. Instead, she was forgiven and could resume her life in peace and freedom from anxiety. She had become a new creation.

Lent is a time for renewal and change. It is a time to believe that "nothing can happen which will outweigh the supreme advantage of knowing Jesus Christ." It is a time to bring our lives, with their failings and sinfulness, to God for healing and forgiveness in the Sacrament of Confession, which is one of the two sacraments of healing, the other being

the "Anointing of the Sick". Confession is about bringing our resolve to change and move in a new direction to God so that we might receive the healing of the Holy Spirit and the strength and courage which are his gifts.

Anyone who has a serious anxiety about their health should receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. In this sacrament, the healing and reconciling power of the Holy Spirit comes to work in the sick person to bring them strength, health, peace and hope. I have administered this sacrament myself, and have received it, and I never cease to be amazed and astonished at its power to bring peace and healing. Often in the most difficult of circumstances.

And then there is 'Confession' or the Sacrament of Reconciliation as it is often called. As in the Sacrament for the Sick, Confession is all about the healing power of the Holy Spirit assuring us of the forgiveness of God and bringing us peace and hope. As Pope Francis said, Confession is not meant to be a torture chamber. It is meant of be liberating and life giving. People often say that they are anxious about coming to confession because they do not know what to say or do not know the correct words. None of that matters. The priest is there to help us explore those aspects of our lives which are crying out for forgiveness and peace.

In addition to the usual times for confessions, when both sacraments are available, (Just ask for the Sacrament of the Sick) I will be available on the following Saturday mornings for Confessions:

Saturday 5th April at Fordingbridge between 11.00 am and 12 noon Saturday 12th April at Ringwood between 11.00 am and 12 noon.
