DIOCESE TEN YEAR PLAN. Let Us Dream: The Diocese of 2032 - A Ten Year Plan. The bishop has been reviewing plans for the future and has identified various priorities and discerned what outcomes he would like to see. This will mean restructuring (reducing the number) of parishes and the re-allocation of priests and deacons. Parishes have been asked to discuss the plans and to feed back to the diocese in November.
