**DCN RICHARD'S "MASS OF JOYFUL HOPE"** A Mass setting composed by Dcn Richard Martin has now been approved for liturgical use by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales Department for Christian Life and Worship. Richard's Mass of Joyful Hope was originally completed in 2014 and has been used very successfully since then in St Joseph's, Christchurch, undergoing minor 'tweaks' on the way and getting it in a suitable form for submission for approval. The Mass is written for Melody/Guitar, so has melody and chords, but not full piano/organ score. The sheet music, which you can download and use FREE of charge, as well as basic audio files to help with learning, are now available on Richard's website RM Creative ([www.rm-creative.uk](http://www.rm-creative.uk)), where you can also find a few of his other compositions and even some poems!
